



resulted in a pending murder case, a civil lawsuit filed against a city, a criminal case being dismissed against a victim of domestic violence who was strangled but charged with an assault, and a guilty plea resulting in a prison sentence and \$27,000 restitution order based on our amicus sentencing brief and affidavit from Dr. Bill Smock being filed in a case

Officially launched the "JUSTICE PROJECT" to continue to consult with families, survivors, and loved ones on potentially mishandled homicide and sexual assault cases
